Important Notes & Reminders:

- **Greetings!** Our school year is underway after successfully completing our first week! Every child has come a long way toward learning classroom rules and routines, as well as good health and safety habits. Please reinforce them through discussion and practice. Our basic rules are:
 - We are kind. (Sharing and keeping hands, feet and objects to ourselves.)
 - We are respectful. (Using good manners and not interrupting someone who is speaking)
 - We are safe. (Follow directions, walk in school, use playground equipment appropriately)
 - We are responsible. (Taking care of the property belonging to myself and others)
- Next week we will begin using each child's red communication folder daily. You will find a daily behavior record sheet to help us keep a two-way dialogue going. I can also be reached at tandereck@gmail.com
- Remember to record the amount of time you and your child read together. As you read, ask your child to predict what will happen next, to tell why something happened, to describe the characters, and to retell the story in order.
- For September birthdays, our class will bake birthday cake later in the month. I may ask for a few parents to send in supplies.
- Be on the lookout for the Alphabet Bag. When the bag comes home, please help your child fill the bag with items that SOUND like the letter indicated on the front of it. Then send the bag back, filled with those items, the following day so that your child can share. Each child in the class will be given an opportunity to take the bag home. Please remember to send the bag back the very next class day.
